Peace, mercy and blessings of God:

We have reviewed your letter No. 12304 dated 6/2/1438 AH regarding your request for guidance regarding the decisions of the Saudi Health Council at its seventy-sixth meeting held on 3/29/1438 AH, numbering nine decisions from (1/76) to No. (9/76) dated on / 1438 3/29 AH.

We reviewed the telegram of His Excellency the Chairman of the Council of Experts at the Council of Ministers No. 3410 dated 3/29/1438 H, attached to Memorandum No. 1231 dated 18/10/1438 and His telegram No. 1142 dated 4/4/139 H, attached to the Memorandum No. 4.4 dated 4/4/1439 H. 13 AH in this regard.

We tell you the following:

First: Approval of the following Saudi Health Council decisions:

A. Resolution No. (2/76) dated 29/3/1438 AH regarding the follow-up to the implementation of the Board's decisions, which include the following:

1- Follow-up with the sectors that did not send their answers or sent incomplete ones to complete them.

2- Assigning the sectors 'coordinators, in cooperation with the council's general secretariat, to implement the electronic program system to follow up on the council's decisions. Resolution No. (3/76) dated 29/3/1438 AH containing the following:

- 1- The health sectors and establishments should periodically report all cancer cases that are receiving treatment, as well as all cases of cancer deaths, to the Saudi Oncology Registry.
- 2- That among the requirements that the National Center for Accreditation of Health Facilities takes when accrediting health facilities is the existence of a database on registering cancer cases in hospitals for which treatment programs are offered.
- 3- Holding a meeting of the Council to discuss the progress of work at the National Center for Accreditation of Health Facilities.

C- Resolution No. (4/76) dated 29/3/1438 AH containing the following:
The need to create a program for partnership between the public and private sectors, one of its tasks:

Establishing a system and legislation for partnership between the public and private sector, and setting national policies related to models of partnership with the private sector. And developing a strategic vision for the private and public sectors with regard to models of partnership in the health sector and developing mechanisms to monitor the implementation of models of Public-private partnership in cooperation between the two sectors.

- 2- The necessity of creating integration and coordination between the health sectors in the health sectors in the public health sector in relation to the strategic plans related to the partnership with the private sector.
- 3- The necessity for the private sector participation to be in stages to ensure the application of quality standards in the proposed models.

- 4- The need to link quality indicators with institutional and individual performance in the health sector..
- 5- The need for a comprehensive economic evaluation of the various geographical areas in the Kingdom according to which the Ministry of Health and other governmental health sectors can determine the needs in the service provided by the health sector.
- 6- Emphasis on reviewing the regulations and policies related to attracting foreign capital and in particular the foreign investment regulations.
7. Continue to hold similar forums and meetings to present views and experiences of both the public and private sectors in the field of partnership between the two sectors and the issues resulting from the implementation of partnership programs.

D. Resolution No. (5/76) dated 29/3/1438 AH containing the following:

- 1- Nominate a member from each sector for membership in the technical committee for the implementation of health accounts to coordinate and facilitate the work of the technical team of the General Secretariat of the Council and the World Health Organization in charge of completing the national health accounts.
- 2- That the detailed report of the national health accounts be presented at the next meeting of the council.

E- Resolution No. (6/76) dated 29/3/1438 AH containing the following:

- 1- Agreeing to employ doctors who are accepted in the Saudi fellowship programs for official vacancies, provided that they are announced to all those admitted to these programs.
- 2- Study the conversion of service jobs under consultants into vacant positions to be directed to by the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties according to the need in each sector.


F. Decision No. (8/76) dated 29/3/1438 H, which includes the health sectors benefiting from attracting foreign experts in accordance with the provisions of Cabinet Resolution No. (147) dated 5/14/1432 H, which to establish a visa in the name (a scientist or expert visa) granted Only for scholars and experts who have been proven to be distinguished in their field of specialization without financial

compensation in accordance with the order mentioned in the aforementioned Cabinet Resolution.

Second: Considering that the Saudi Health Council Decisions No. From the health system issued by Royal Decree No. (11 / M) dated 23/3/1423 AH that the decisions of the Saudi Health Council are binding on the health sectors after they are approved by the Prime Minister.

The General Secretariat of the Council of Ministers was provided with a copy of this order to complete the necessary regarding the referral of Resolution No. (7/76) on 3/29/1438 AH regarding the draft health ethics system to the Council of Ministers, so complete what is required under it.
