Subject: Variation in the form and content of the medical reports related to fingerprinting

The Saudi Health Council:

After reviewing the letter of His Royal Highness, the Crown Prince, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Interior No. 11980 dated 5/9/1438 AH regarding the discrepancy in the form and content of medical reports that come from hospitals and medical centers related to the passage of the fingerprint of citizens, the multiplicity of its sources, and the different forms of seals on them.

And after reviewing the recommendations of the Preparatory Committee at its forty-second meeting held on 5/17/1438 AH

And after discussion of the issue by the members of the Council at the seventy-seventh meeting, held on 6/23/1437 AH

The following was decided:

1. Determine the main hospital of the Ministry of Health in each region (in addition to hospitals of other government sectors in both Riyadh and Jeddah), provided that one or two consultants are identified who are entitled to issue reports of overprinting for citizens after approval by the hospital director.
2. That the medical report be issued by the Civil Status Department in the region.
3. There should be an electronic link between the Ministry of Interior Agency for Civil Status and the hospitals with the authority to issue the report.
